Frequently Asked Questions

REGISTRATION

How can I register for the camp?

Registration will be done online, through the vendor booking system. You can find the link to the booking system through the CMC Church Camp 2025 website (www.cmc.org.sg/camp2025). **Please note that registration is on a first-come-first-serve basis and full payment must be made to secure your booking.**

If you require any assistance, please find us at the Church Camp Booth. Dates are provided under 'Payment'.

Registration closes when all rooms has been booked or 13 Apr 2025, whichever is earlier.

Can I extend my stay before or after the camp?

You will be able to book a 1 night pre-camp stay in the vendor's online system. For any other arrangements, please book directly with a third party booking service or directly with the hotel as the vendor's online system will not be able to accommodate your request.

1 night pre-camp stay will cost \$150 per room for twin sharing, and \$200 per room for triple sharing. Breakfast will be included.

PAYMENT

How do I make payment?

Upon successful online registration, an acknowledgement email will be sent to you with a Booking Reference No. Payment can be made via PayNow (preferred), cheque or cash.

PayNow App

Please scan the QR code on the right or make payment to Christ Methodist Church UEN: S87CC0528A.

Please indicate '**CAMP**' + **Booking Reference No.** and your **Name** in the description based on the following format:

CAMP Booking Ref-Name (e.g. **CAMP CMCX100A JohnTan**)

Kindly email the screenshot your PayNow transaction receipt to camp2025@cmc.org.sg. Alternatively, you may choose to drop off a printed copy of your transaction receipt at the Church Camp Booth.

Cheque Payment

Please write your cheque to "Christ Methodist Church" and indicate your name, contact number and Booking Reference No. on the reverse side of the cheque. Kindly submit only ONE cheque per Booking Reference No. Find us at the Church Camp Booth to submit the cheque.

Cash Payment

Cash payment can be made at the Church Camp Booth. Please bring the exact amount, and remember to have a copy of your Booking Reference No. ready.

How do I know if my payment has gone through, and the booking has been confirmed?

A booking confirmation email will be sent to the Room IC within 2 weeks from the day of payment.

When will the Church Camp Booth be open?

You can find the Church Camp Booth at the fellowship deck on the following dates

- Saturday Service – 8 Feb and 8 Mar
- Sunday Service – 9 Feb, 23 Feb, 9 Mar and 23 Mar (from 9am – 10:15am and 12noon – 12:45pm).

How do I cancel my registration? Can I get a refund?

Cancellation must be made in writing to camp2025@cmc.org.sg by 6 Apr 2025 to qualify for a refund.



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ACCOMODATION @ Putrajaya Marriott Hotel

What is the cost for the camp?

* Child age : 3 – 11 years old

Remarks :

- Each room must have at least 1 adult (i.e. 12 years old and above)
- 2-way coach transfer is provided on 9 June 2025 and 12 June 2025 only
- Coach fees are 100% subsidised by CMC but chargeable in event of no show or cancellation after registration closes
- Prestay Twin Room @SGD150 per room per night, with 2 breakfast
- Prestay Triple Room @SGD200 per room per night, with 3 breakfast

Above Camp Fees includes :

- Hotel accommodation for 3-Night stay
- Meals – 3 breakfast, 2 lunches, 3 dinners will be provided during the camp

Can I room with someone of the opposite sex?

Rooming with the opposite sex is only allowed for spouses and siblings.

What if I have any special requests?

You may indicate your requests (e.g. accessible showers etc) when you book online for your room arrangements. We will do our best to facilitate your requests and to communicate your needs to the hotel. Do note that requests are also subject to availability.

What are the amenities in the room?

- Deluxe Guest Room (1 king bed or 2 twin beds)
- Cable TV
- WIFI internet
- Standard toilet amenities (bath towels, toiletries, etc.)
- Mini fridge (emptied)

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GETTING THERE

How much does the 2-way coach transfer cost?

The 2-way coach transfer costs \$50. This amount will be fully subsidised by church. However, in the event that you booked but fail to utilise the 2-way coach transfer, you will be required to make the reimbursement of \$50 after the camp.

How long is the coach journey to Putrajaya Marriot Hotel?

It will take approximately 7 - 8 hours, including immigration clearance, toilet and lunch breaks. More information will be provided at the briefing.

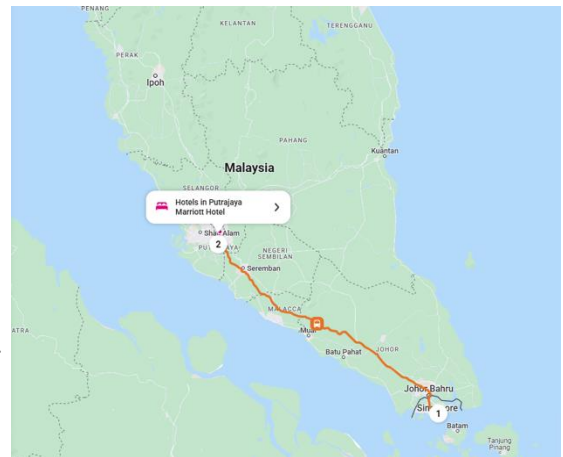
Can I book 1-way coach transfer?

If you need 1-way coach transfer, please indicate this under the special request section or drop us an email with your Booking Reference. We will try our best to fulfil your request. Please note that priority will be given to campers who need 2-way transfer.

How else can I get to Putrajaya Marriot Hotel?

You may self-drive or charter your own transport. Kindly note that vehicles travelling between Singapore and Malaysia are subject to tolls, fees and charges. Motorists are to ensure sufficient value in your TnG cards. Please also ensure that your car is registered for Vehicle Entry Permit (VEP) with the Malaysian Government (Visit <https://vep.jpj.gov.my/#/> for more information). Parking at the hotel is free-of-charge for hotel guests. Please aim to arrive by Monday (9 June), 4pm as we plan to start the programme around that time. However, the programme may be delayed due to the congestion at the causeway. We seek your understanding on this.

Alternatively, you may fly to Kuala Lumpur International Airport, and transfer via a taxi to the hotel. Do note that the hotel is about 45 minutes away via taxi to the hotel. As we plan to break camp by 1pm, please arrange your airport transfers accordingly. Lunch will not be provided.



Do I need to apply for a Visa for Entry into Malaysia?

For Singapore passport holders, no visa is required for a stay of up to 30 days. For all other passport holders, please refer to https://www.kln.gov.my/web/sgp_singapore/requirement_foreign for more information.

Travel Insurance

Travel Insurance is highly recommended. Please purchase your own travel insurance AFTER you have received confirmation for your camp booking. Travel Insurance can help protect you from unexpected situations like overseas medical expenses, trip cancellations and other travel-related risks.

Passport Requirements

You may apply or renew your passport via ICA's [eService](#) using your SingPass if your current passport has a validity of less than 7 months, or contain no space / pages for visas. For Foreign Passport Holders, please check with your respective embassy or consulate on how to renew your passport.

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OTHERS

When will the camp briefing be conducted?

The briefing on the details of camp will be conducted on 25 May 2025. Please ensure you will be able to attend the briefing or arrange for someone to attend on your behalf.

Can I bring my infant and/or child to the camp sessions?

Good news! For this year, we have 2 children's program:

1. Primary Level Program - 7-12 years old
2. Preschool Level Program - 4-6 years old

For children 2-3 years old, they can join in the Preschool program but they must be accompanied by 1 adult throughout the sessions. For young children joining in the main program, we seek your understanding and cooperation to take your child out of the hall should there be any distractions so that other campers may soak in the sessions without any disruption.

What programmes are available for both levels?

For both programmes, kids can look forward to a series of interactive and fun-filled activities that will help to grow their faith in God.

For Primary Level, we have engaged Gerard Kevin and team. Gerard was the camp speaker for last year's CK Bible Boot Camp in Jun 24.

For Preschool Level, the team from Scripture Union will be helming the programme.

Can my youth stay with me during the camp session?

Your youth can join you for the main speaker sessions. However, we highly encourage them to sit with their allocated youth camp group in order to foster stronger bonds. We also highly encourage them to be part of the youth camp group discussions during session breakout times.

Is there a special program for youth?

Youth will be following the same program as the rest of the camp. However, there may be youth gathering during meal times. More details will be provided via youth camp groups.

Can I bring a non-CMC member?

We welcome everyone but please ensure that they are informed that it is a church camp.

Can I bring my domestic helper?

Yes, standard camp fees will apply.

What do I need to bring to get the most out of the sessions?

Your Bible and a shawl or light jacket to keep warm. Most importantly, bring along an expectation to meet God and be open to the work of the Holy Spirit.
